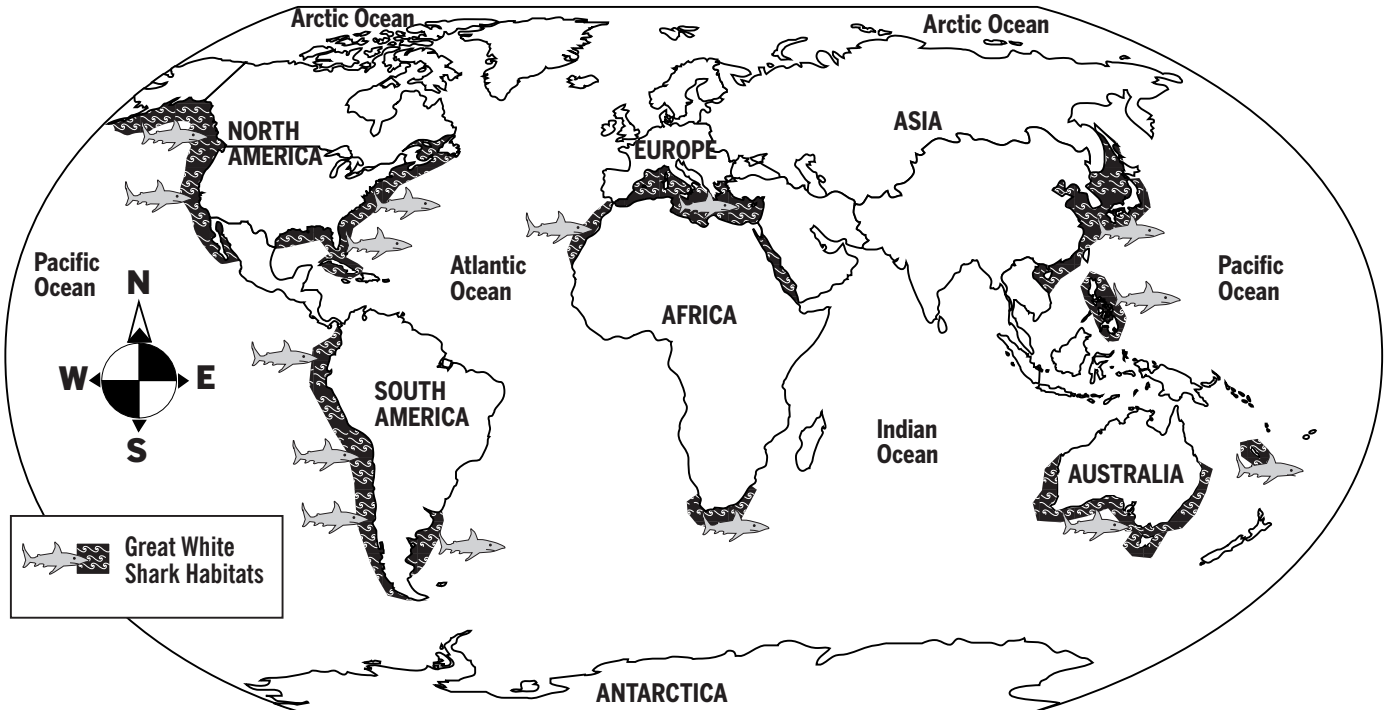


Where a Great White Shark Swims



Bull sharks can live in fresh water, but most sharks, including the great white, live in the world's oceans. Since 1999 scientists have been attaching electronic tags to great white sharks. The tags allow researchers to track the movements of individual sharks. The map below shows where great white sharks normally live. Use the map to answer the questions.
