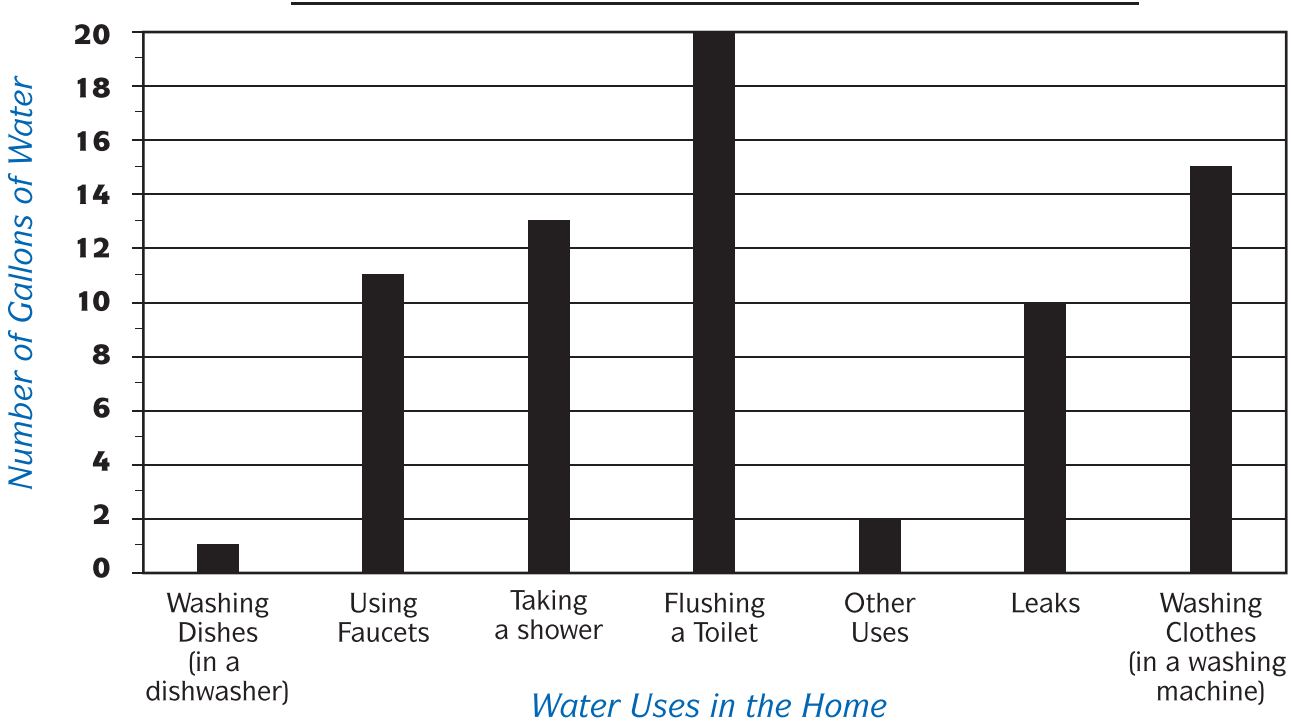


Get WATER-WISE!
