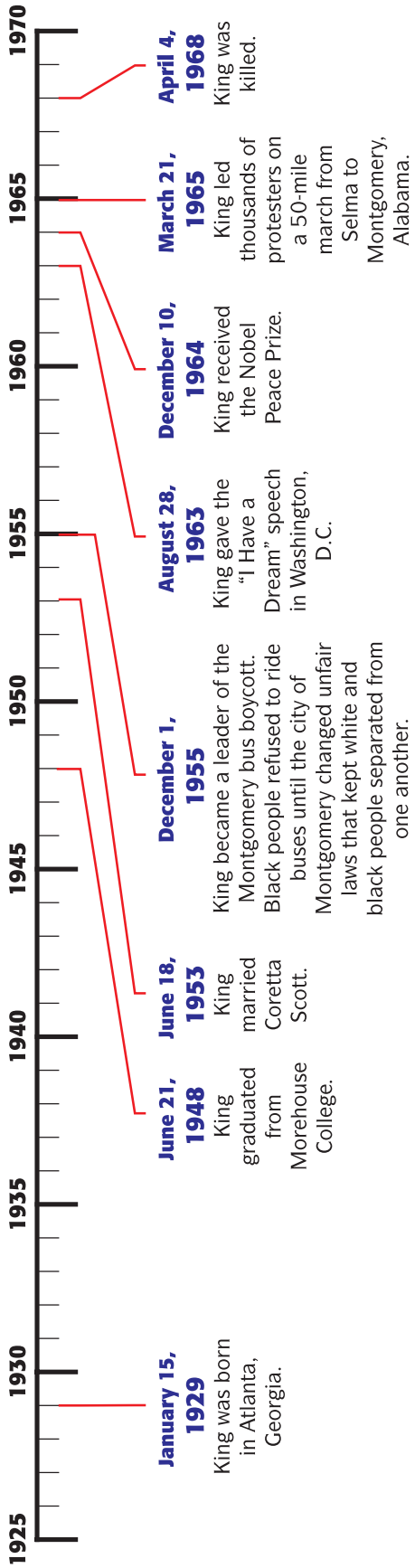


THE LIFE OF A LEADER
