NEED INSPIRATION?

- Research ways to promote different kinds of literacy in your community. What groups or events need more attention and support?
- Ask a librarian for information about the library's programs to help learners. Is there a way you can participate in these efforts?
- Know multiple languages? Read a book with someone who wants to learn one of them.

Need help getting started? Talk to an adult or pair up with a friend to find an idea that feels right for you.

Reading to young children helps them develop strong literacy skills. Plus, it's fun! Ask a teacher for permission to visit a classroom of younger students. Have your classmates help you select books that you can read aloud. It's story time!
